



"ROXI" CARDIGAN

GIADA Yarn

YARN

ADRIAFIL YARN

MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 400 g. **Giada** yarn in beige no. 37
- knitting needles no. 51/2
- crochet hook no. 5
- 1 button in matching colour

- tapestry needle

SIZE: 40 (42-44)

PATTERN STITCHES

Purled stitch

Chain stitch

Double crochet

Half treble crochet

GAUGE

10x10 cm. working with knitting needles no. 51/2 in purl st. = 16 sts. and 21 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

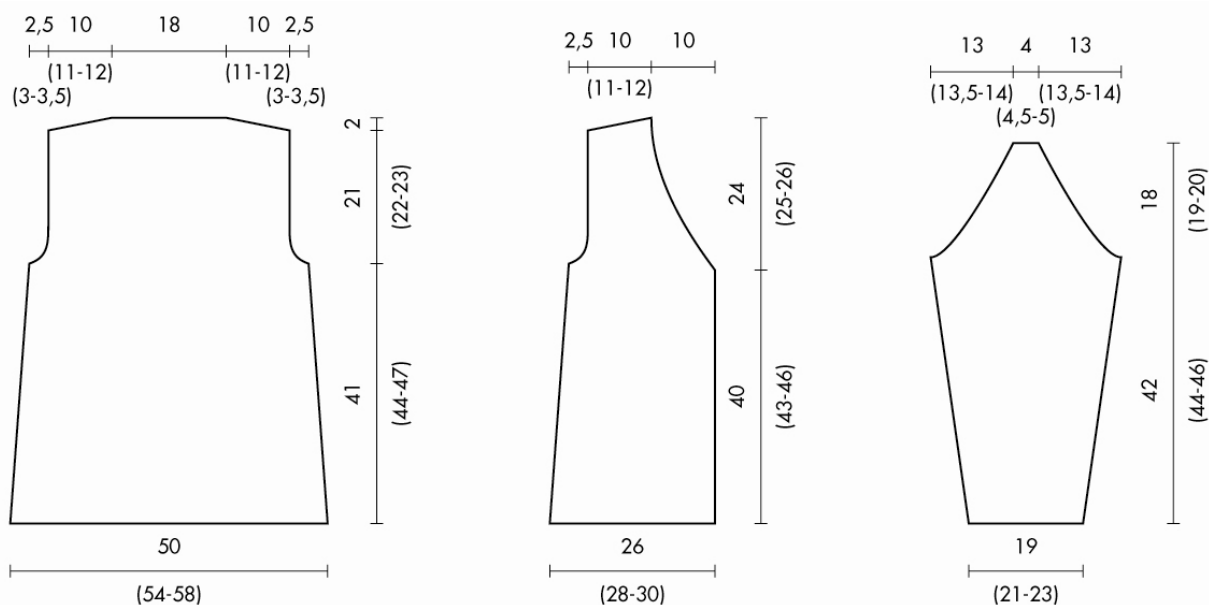
N.B. To obtain a softer effect, work with larger needles than those indicated by the label.

Back: with the knitting needles cast on 80 (86-92) sts. and work in purl st. At the ends dec. 1 st. every 10 rows 6 times. When work measures a total of 41 (44-47) cm., to shape the sleeve holes cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 2 sts., 1 st. 2 (3-4) times. When work measures 21 (22-23) cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, to shape the shoulders cross off at ends 8 (9-10) sts. every 2 rows, twice. Bind off the 28 rem. stitches.

Right front: cast on 42 (45-48) sts. and work in purl st. On left of work shape the side in the same way as back. When work measures a total of 40 (43-46) cm., to shape the neckline cross off on right of work 1 st. every 2 rows 10 times, 1 st. every 4 rows, 4 times, 1 st. every 6 rows, twice. At the same time, when work measures a total of 41 (44-47) cm., shape the sleeve hole and, when work measures 21 (22-23) cm. from beg. of sleeve hole, slant the shoulder, on left of work, in the same way as back.

Left front: work to match right front.

Sleeves: with the knitting needles cast on 30 (33-36) sts. and work in purl st. At ends incr. 1 st. every 8 rows 9, turn work. When work measures a total of 42 (44-46) cm., to shape the sleeve holes cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 2 sts., 1 st. 19 (20-21) times. When work measures 18 (19-20) cm. from beg. of sleeve holes bind off the 6 (7-8) rem. stitches.



MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulders. With the crochet hook trim the front and back neckline as follows:

Row 1: start from 4th st. of the neckline of the right front and work in dc. distributing 37 (39-41) sts. along the neckline of each front and 30 (32-34) sts. along the back neckline; ending in the 4th last st. of the neckline of left front.

From rows 2 to 9, work in half tr.

Rows 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6: work the first and last 6 half trs. and all the rem. centre sts. in half tr., decreasing at the ends 1 tr. every row

Row 7: work in half tr., only over the first 32 (34-36) sts. (standing off all the rem. sts.) and, at the same time, decr. 1 st. over the first and last 2 sts.

Rows 8 and 9: work 1 half tr., in each st. below cont. work even on the side edge of the first 6 rows (only on neckline side); bind off the yarn at the 4th and 3rd slipped sts. at beg. of neckline.

Break off and bind the yarn. The first lapel has now been completed. Pick up work over the last 37 (39-41) sts. and work the second lapel to match the previous. Break off and bind the yarn.

Pick up work over the standing centre sts. and work 3 rows in half tr., working 1 st. on each st. below. Break off and bind the yarn. Trim the edges of the collar and lapels with 1 row in dc. working 1 6 chs. buttonhole at the base of the lapel of the right front. Sew up the sides. Bind off and join the sleeves. With the crochet hook trim the bottom of the sleeves working 4 rows in dc. Sew on the button at the base of the lapel of the left front.
